## **TOUR SUMMARY**

Spain is well known as one of the tourism capitals of the world. Its cultural treasures are justly renowned. What's less known is that it has some of Europe's best birding. If you have never birded in Europe before, this is a great place to start. And if you have birded elsewhere on the continent, Spain is sure to have a lot of new species and provide a wonderful experience.

One of the beauties of this trip is that we're based in just two picturesque and historical small towns: Trujillo, Extremadura, and El Rocio, Andalucia. These towns are so delightful that when the group compiled its favorite experiences of the trip, these towns themselves scored number one and two! Of course, there was great birding in the woodland and cliffs of Monfragüe, the steppes surrounding Trujillo, and the wetlands and woodlands of the Doñana region. Highlights of Monfragüe included Spanish (Imperial) Eagle (see the cover photo above), Cinereous Griffon, Black Stork, and Western Subalpine Warbler. The steppes had a very different suite of birds, which included Great and Little Bustards, Pin-tailed and Black-bellied Sandgrouse, and legions of Calandra Larks. The estuaries of Andalucia are some of Europe's most diverse

birding areas. Just a few of many highlights included White-headed and Marbled Ducks, Greater Flamingo, Western Swamphen, Red-knobbed Coot, and Collared Pratincole.

The accommodations throughout this trip are very comfortable, and the food was superb, including excellent seafood, olives, and perhaps the world's best pork, often in the form of the famous Iberian *jamón*.

April 6	Arrival in Madrid. Night Madrid.
April 7	Madrid to Monfragüe NP. Night Trujillo, Extremadura.
April 8	Morning Belén and Cáceres Steppes. Afternoon Monfragüe NP. Night Trujillo.
April 9	Morning Cáceres Steppe. Afternoon at Arrocampo Reservoir. Night Trujillo.
April 10	Morning Cáceres Steppe. Drive to El Rocío, Andalucía. Night El Rocío.
April 11	Doñana NP. Night El Rocío.
April 12	Morning Odiel Estuary. Afternoon Doñana NP. Night El Rocío.
April 13	Morning Doñana NP. Drive to Sevilla. Night Sevilla.
April 14	Departure from Sevilla (flight to Barcelona for those joining the northern Spain trip)
